Ford boosts Mustang Shelby GT500 to 650 hp for 2013 model

The all-new Escape SUV might be more important to Ford's bottom line, but the 2013 Mustang line being unveiled at the Los Angeles auto show is more exciting --starting with the 650-hp GT500.

Yes--650 hp for the 2013 Mustang Shelby GT500. It's the most powerful Mustang ever, and it almost certainly will be the least expensive 650-hp new car money can buy.

Credit Ford for not letting the Mustang get stale or soft. A year after the debut of the Boss 302, the lineup remains the same, with a V6, a GT 5.0, a Boss and a GT500. Yet all get a mild facelift for 2013, with improvements across the board. There's a more aggressive shark snout in front, standard HID projector-beam headlights trimmed with LED strips, and three-bar LED taillight/turn signals that flash sequentially. Puddle lights in the outside mirrors cast light in the pattern of the Mustang pony logo.

The 2013 Mustang GT gets LED fog lights and a bump from 412 hp to 420 hp, thanks to internal-friction reductions in the engine. The six-speed Select Shift automatic will allow full manual control, with no default upshift at the redline. Recaro seats will be available all the way down to the V6, in cloth or leather.

There will be new performance packages, upgraded audio systems and a new option called Track Apps, with an on-board accelerometer. Track Apps can save and display lap times, quarter-mile times and g-loads on the new 4.2-inch LCD in the center stack, not to mention a range of engine telemetry options, right down to cylinder-head temperatures

Next Ford Mustang GT will channel GT500

After decades of dominating the pony car sales charts, the Ford Mustang has finally met its match in the latest Chevrolet Camaro. Naturally, this high-profile segment, is one that Ford is loathe to concede. After being infused with completely new engines in 2011, the Mustang will soon receive a visual refreshening that aligns this horse's looks even more with the range-topping Shelby GT500 model.

Our spy photographers have snapped a Mustang GT prototype with just a thin layer of 3M vinyl hiding the changes. Up front, you can clearly see the GT500's influence in this Mustang prototype's protruding grille. Also note that the coupe has dropped the Mustang GT's circular, grille-mounted fog lamps, as well as swapped out its galloping horse badge for a new logo that's been moved from the center of the grille to the side. Even the lower air intake is shaped like an open smile, just like on the current GT500. And, is that a splitter we see hanging off the car's chin?

We can also see brand new projector beam headlights up front with some LED tech buried within, and out back, the rear end gets new taillights. That rear wing is also new, and the rear bumper has been slightly redesigned as well.

Ford clearly hopes to imbue the Mustang GT with the GT500's aggressive looks, and these spy shots show they're on-track to do just that. Will it be enough to boost sales above the Camaro? We'll see. The more interesting question is once the Mustang GT looks like the GT500, what will Ford do with its most powerful pony car? With the impending arrival of the 580-horsepower Camaro ZL1, we're sure Ford's got something planned.

Shelby American marks its 50th with U.S. tour

Shelby American will take a national tour in 2012 to celebrate the 50 years since Carroll Shelby launched the brand.

The U.S. tour will be reminiscent of the original Shelby <u>Caravan</u> in the mid-1960s, according to Shelby American president John Luft. He said the tour will feature collectibles and other merchandise commemorating the anniversary. It will also serve as a public debut of the limited-edition 50th Anniversary Shelby vehicles.

"Since Carroll created the first Cobra and founded his company in 1962, the Shelby name has become the cornerstone of high performance," Luft said.

Upcoming highlights and the tour plan are featured in this year's *Shelby Annual* publication. Content highlights include features on the original Cobra, the Shelby GT350 and the GT500 Super Snake.

Updates on the events and schedule for the Shelby American 50th Anniversary Tour will be at www.shelby50th.com. The Web site will also house live video from each stop of the tour when it kicks off in 2012.

Internet Insecurity: The 25 Worst Passwords of 2011

You've got locks on your doors and maybe even an alarm system guarding your home. But all that stands between criminals and your bank account information is the word "password." Sound familiar? "Password," "123456" and, weirdly, "monkey" are among the 25 worst passwords of the year, according to SplashData, a private company that sells security services and password software.

SplashData compiled its list -- released Monday -- from files containing millions of stolen passwords posted online by hackers.

And despite all the fancy technology available to hackers, when it comes to breaking and entering, they'll still go for the low-hanging fruit, starting with easy passwords like these.

Here's a tip for creating a more secure password: Make it eight characters or more, and use multiple types of characters -- upper- and lower-case letters, numbers and symbols. (For more tips, read *DailyFinance's* article on how to create safe, memorable passwords.)
